There will be a 5K & 10k, and a free 1K fun walk open to all ages and abilities.

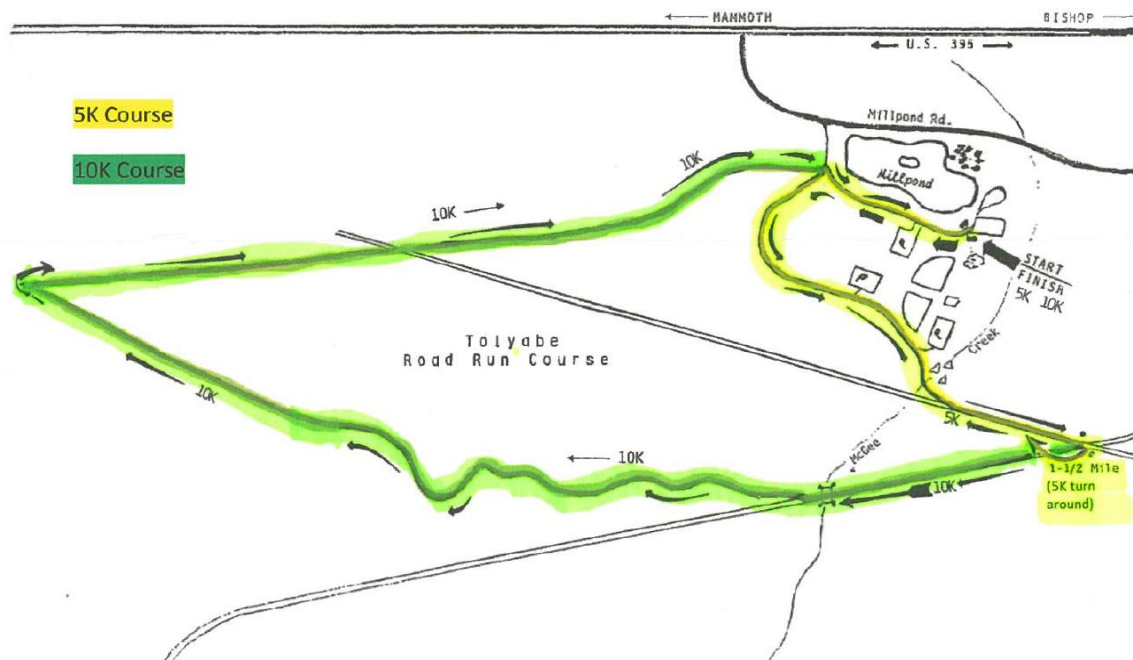
